A full-packed weekend of concerts/events in July was another seasonal celebration and a gift to our community! From the historic Greystone Mansion to the hip roof-top at Petit Ermitage and Finale Concert at the Municipal Gallery at the City Hall of Beverly Hills, our Stellar Alumni wowed the audiences, dedicated and new. In this 28th season, featured alumni were Austrian violinist Yury Revich, Canadian violist Juan-Miguel Hernandez, Ecuadorian cellist Francisco Vila, and American-Russian pianist Svetlana Smolina. Our new find, flutist Nikka Gershman, was a star in Mozart's Flute Quartet. The audiences were treated to "freshly prepared" selections, from Yury's own compositions to Martinu's violin/viola duo to Brahms' piano quartet.

In 2023, after 25 seasons of local and international accolades, naming the festival "...one of the highlights — in some years, THE highlight — of the summer here," iPalpiti festival transitioned into biennial production. Presenting interim mini-festivals allows the organization to focus on grants and awards to the artists, catalogue and digitize massive historical recordings and materials, special artistic projects, and allowing iPalpiti's Maestro Eduard Schmieder to take on other summer engagements.



PROJECT: iPALPITI LEGACY

iPalpiti amassed a vast archival collection of recordings and media assets (in addition to the 29 released albums and hundreds of public videos). On the initiative and under the supervision of iPalpiti' Chairman Mikhail Gershfeld, CalPoly Pomona Computer Science students and their advisor, Professor Fatemeh Jamshidi, are collaborating with iPalpiti on the development of a custom software platform designed to digitize, organize, archive, and preserve our artistic treasure. Code-named iPalpiti Legacy, the platform will serve as a cultural memory bank, while enabling secure licensing for educational, broadcast, and creative use. Once completed, the project may also open new revenue streams to help sustain iPalpiti's mission.
