The Festival opens in Encinitas, CA. This will be our 6th season there, and we now have a growing and enthusiastic following. From July 13 to 16, daily Virtuosi concerts will showcase six iPalpiti soloists performing rare and popular works from the classic, romantic, and modern periods. On July 16th, the rest of the iPalpiti will arrive and, after a three-day residency, will give a concert as orchestral ensemble on July 19th at the St. Andrew's Church. Then, following a residence at Soka Performing Arts Center from July 20-23 will culminate an ALL SCHUBERT concert of the iPalpiti orchestra on **July 23rd** featuring **violinist Kazuhiro Takagi** in the Schubert Rondo.

In Los Angeles July 23-30, iPalpiti Soloists will present chamber works at Sunday's Live @ LACMA: July 23rd will feature Korean violinist Gyehee Kim, with Italian pianist Jacopo Giacopuzzi. The July 30th program presents two illustrious alumni in Chausson's Concerto for Violin, Piano and String Quartet. The July 26th concert at Greystone Mansion will feature the Tchaikovsky Piano Trio and the July 27th concert at UCLA's Powell Library Rotunda will present the Schubert Cello Quintet.

The grand finale at **Walt Disney Concert Hall on July 29 will present a** *MAJESTIC CLASSICS* programs of Schubert, Mozart, and Beethoven. Included will be **Mozart's Adagio and Fuga** - a rare chance to hear this foreboding and mysterious composition (the only other known performances given in Los Angeles were by LACO in 1993 and iPalpiti in 2003!) as well as the beloved **Sinfonia Concertante** for violin (Samuel Nebyu) and viola (Juan-Miguel Hernandez). Maestro is known for his "imaginative and increasingly unpredictable programming...not afraid to select favorites or obscurities from the past in styles that have gone out of fashion; nor reluctant to try new things..."




